## The Roles of Teachers, Parents and Students at Cor Deo

Cor Deo is an integration of Christian school with independent study, a unique blend for parents who desire to be involved in their student's education but want the consistency, accountability, and expertise that a traditional school can provide. Our school provides the flexibility for - and strongly encourages - parents to augment their children's education by teaching other subjects at home or involving them in music lessons, personal hobbies, fitness activities (such as sports leagues), or other activities of interest to the children or family.

Cor Deo and its classroom teachers will be responsible for developing curriculum, lesson plans, coursework, instruction, grading, transcripts and diplomas. Classroom instruction is administered on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. On Tuesdays and Thursdays, students study independently. Parents ensure work assignments are carried out in accordance with the teachers' work assignments.

It is important to understand that Cor Deo Christian Academy is a 5 day a week school. There is work that needs to get done on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Different grade levels will have different parent involvement on Tuesdays and Thursdays:

Grades: K-2	High Parent Involvement
Grades: 3-6	Medium Parent Involvement
Grades: 7-8	Low Parent Involvement

Definitions:

High:	punctuality, reading directions, explaining, organizing, correcting work
Medium:	punctuality, organizing, explaining, observing- correcting work
Low:	punctuality, encouraging, some correcting of work

Estimate of time on Tuesdays and Thursdays: (times vary for different students)

Kindergarten	1-2 hours
Grades: 1-2	2-3 hours
Grades: 3-4	3-4 hours
Grades: 5-6	5-6 hours
Grades: 7-8	7-10 hours

## Statement of Faith

**The Bible.** The entire 66 books of the Bible are the Holy Spirit-authenticated word of God.<sup>1</sup> Although the Bible was written by human authors in a variety of styles and genres, it is “God breathed”<sup>2</sup> and is without error in the original manuscripts<sup>3</sup>. It is truthful and trustworthy, and it has supreme authority in all it addresses<sup>4</sup>. It is the complete written word of God<sup>5</sup> and should be studied diligently by all people<sup>6</sup>.

**God.** There is only one living and true God<sup>7</sup> creator of heaven and earth<sup>8</sup> who is infinite in being and perfection<sup>9</sup>. Everything that takes place is under His sovereign control<sup>10</sup>. He is a transcendent spirit who is distinct from His creation<sup>11</sup>, but he is also intimately involved in every detail<sup>12</sup> and is knowable<sup>13</sup>. God is all powerful<sup>14</sup>, all knowing<sup>15</sup>, everywhere present<sup>16</sup>, unchanging<sup>17</sup>, loving<sup>18</sup>, holy<sup>19</sup>, just<sup>20</sup>, and glorious<sup>21</sup>. His perfect knowledge extends to all things past, present, and future, including the future decisions of His free creatures<sup>22</sup>. God is eternally existing<sup>23</sup> in three persons<sup>24</sup> who are equal in every divine attribute and who execute distinct but harmonious roles<sup>25</sup> in the work of creation, providence and redemption:

- **God the Father**, who bears this name especially in relation to the Son<sup>26</sup> and to His children<sup>27</sup>, is the originator of all things and initiates revelation<sup>28</sup>, creation<sup>29</sup>, redemption<sup>30</sup>, and covenant relationship with His people.

- **God the Son**, is the eternally existent Son of God<sup>31</sup> and is equal to the Father as deity<sup>32</sup>. In fact, as the Word<sup>33</sup> and image of God<sup>34</sup>, He is the most definitive revelation of all God is<sup>35</sup>. He was incarnated as the man Jesus<sup>36</sup>, being conceived by the Holy Spirit<sup>37</sup> and born of the virgin Mary<sup>38</sup>. We believe in His sinless life<sup>39</sup>, miracles, and teachings. We also believe in His substitutionary atoning death<sup>40</sup>, bodily resurrection<sup>41</sup>, ascension into heaven<sup>42</sup>, perpetual intercession for His people<sup>43</sup>, future visible return to earth<sup>44</sup>, and eternal dominion over all people<sup>45</sup>.

- **God the Spirit** is a personal being<sup>46</sup> equal as deity to the Father and the Son<sup>47</sup>. He was sent by the Father and the Son<sup>48</sup> to glorify Christ<sup>49</sup>; to convict the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment<sup>50</sup>; and to regenerate<sup>51</sup>, sanctify<sup>52</sup>, and empower<sup>53</sup> all who believe in Jesus Christ. Believers have communion with the Father and the Son through the Holy Spirit<sup>54</sup>. The Holy Spirit dwells in every believer in Christ<sup>55</sup>, and He is their abiding helper<sup>56</sup>, teacher<sup>57</sup>, and guide<sup>58</sup>. Knowing God better<sup>59</sup>, loving and delighting in Him and His ways<sup>60</sup>, and bringing Him joy<sup>61</sup> should be the chief goal of every person.

**People.** Adam and Eve, who were historic people, were created in the moral and spiritual image of God as free, rational, and relational beings and were given responsibility for and authority over God’s creation<sup>62</sup>. Even after the Fall, all people retain the image of God<sup>63</sup> and therefore have great value and worth. All people are sinners by nature due to the Fall<sup>64</sup> and by choice<sup>65</sup>, and therefore they are under condemnation<sup>66</sup>, leading to spiritual and physical death<sup>67</sup>. People are corrupted by sin in every area of life<sup>68</sup>, hostile toward God and incapable of pleasing Him<sup>69</sup>.

**Salvation.** People are so dead and lost in sin<sup>70</sup> that they can only be saved by God’s initiative, as God works in their hearts<sup>71</sup>. A right relationship with God can only be obtained through the atoning death of the righteous one, Jesus Christ<sup>72</sup>, Who came to earth by God’s gracious predetermined plan<sup>73</sup>. Those who repent of their sins and trust in Jesus Christ alone for their salvation (Galatians) are saved by grace<sup>74</sup> and preserved in the faith<sup>75</sup> by the Holy Spirit<sup>76</sup>.

## Statement of Faith

**The Church.** Jesus is actively building the universal church,<sup>77</sup> a living spiritual body of which Christ is the head<sup>78</sup> and all His followers are members<sup>79</sup>. We also believe in the local church, consisting of believers in Jesus Christ who should be baptized on a credible profession of faith and associated for worship, ministry, and fellowship<sup>80</sup>. We believe the local church glorifies God by worshiping Him, edifying one another in love<sup>81</sup>, and proclaiming the full word of God to every people group<sup>82</sup>. We also believe that local church leaders (Elders) should be male<sup>83</sup> and should have authority<sup>84</sup> and the responsibility to lovingly discipline members who refuse to repent of sin<sup>85</sup>.

**Baptism.** The Lord Jesus has committed to the local church two sacred ceremonies: baptism and the Lord's Supper. Although baptism is not necessary for salvation<sup>86</sup>, Christ commands and expects it as an act of obedience by every true believer<sup>87</sup>. Because Christian baptism is a symbol of our new life of union with Christ in His death, burial, and resurrection, and because of the very meaning of the word "baptism," it is best carried out by immersion in water, and it is to be performed in the name of the triune God<sup>88</sup>.

**Communion.** The Lord's Supper ("Communion") was instituted by Christ as a commemoration of His sacrificial death and should be observed regularly until he returns<sup>89</sup>. The elements are symbolic of Christ's once-for-all sacrifice; therefore, we are not actually eating the body and blood of Jesus, nor do the elements inherently impart grace. Nevertheless, the visual reminder of Christ's death and new covenant eaten by sincere believers in obedience to the Lord and in fellowship together nourishes our relationship with Christ and with each other.

**Progressive Sanctification.** At the moment of salvation (justification), the Holy Spirit fully dwells in each Christian<sup>90</sup> and increasingly produces fruit<sup>91</sup>, such as love, obedience to God, humility, sexual purity, generosity, and spiritual maturity—all leading to greater and greater Christlikeness<sup>92</sup>. As Christians we need to follow the leading of the Holy Spirit and with His help put off all types of sin<sup>93</sup>. Sanctification culminates in glorification, which is the final blessed state of the redeemed.

**Christians and Civil Government.** The civil government is a third human social institution (along with the family and the church) ordained by God. Its specific ministry is encouraging righteousness, administering justice, defending life and property, and restraining evil<sup>94</sup>. It is not independent of God, but subject to Him<sup>95</sup>. We are to be subject to lawful civil authorities<sup>96</sup> yet may participate in influencing the laws and administration as citizens and holders of public office. However, we must respectfully disobey laws and commands of the civil government and accept the penalties whenever those laws are clearly contrary to the Bible<sup>97</sup>.

**Truth.** All truth corresponds to objective spiritual and physical reality because God is the author of Scripture and the creator and sustainer of nature<sup>98</sup>. Such objective truth is grounded in the person and character of the Triune God<sup>99</sup>. As a result, it does not change with circumstances, time, or culture and is independent of what any person or group thinks about the world. Proclaiming the truth as revealed by the Scriptures is one of the primary tasks of the church<sup>100</sup>. The scientific method and other means of knowledge that are consistent with the scriptural worldview are useful in discovering truth about God's creation. Scientific and experiential knowledge may inform but should never dictate how we interpret the Bible. Instead, the Bible is the final authority to which all truth claims must submit.

**The Family.** The family consists of people united by marriage, biological relationship, or adoption. **Marriage** is the uniting of one man and one woman in covenant commitment for a lifetime, modeling the relationship between Christ and the church<sup>101</sup>. **The husband and wife** are of equal worth before God, since both are created in God's image.<sup>102</sup> **A husband** is to love his wife as Christ loved the church and to exercise his God-given responsibility to lead his family<sup>103</sup>. **A wife** is to submit herself graciously to the servant leadership of her husband even as the church willingly submits to the headship of Christ<sup>104</sup>. **Children**, from the moment of conception, are a blessing from the Lord<sup>105</sup>. **Parents**—not the church or the state—have the primary responsibility to direct and develop their children, and they will be
